Dear Parent/Carers,

Welcome back to the final half term of this academic year. I hope you all had a lovely break.

This half term will be a busy one with lots of events taking place.

Health & Safety.

As part of our Health & Safety commitment, staff will not be available to speak to parents or carers other than at the beginning or end of the school day. They will not be available once the school day has begun. A member of the Senior Management Team will be happy to speak to you. Once a child has left school for the day, if a parent or carer has something they wish to discuss this will need to be discussed the following day. Telephone queries, before and after school will be dealt with whilst staff are available.

Uniform/School Shoes.

I have noticed recently that some children are coming into school wearing their yellow PE shirts. Can I remind parents that the yellow polo shirts should be worn for PE only. Children are expected to wear either a white polo shirt or white cotton shirt as part of their school uniform. I have also noticed a growing number of children wearing trainers in school. These should be worn for PE only. Appropriate black/brown school shoes not boots, should be worn in line with our school policy. Your support in this matter is appreciated.

PE KIT Unfortunately there are still a number of children who are not bringing their PE Kit into school each week. Parents are reminded that PE is part of the school curriculum and therefore all children must take part. Kits MUST be brought in each Monday morning and remain in school until Friday when they should be taken home for washing. Parents will be contacted and asked to bring in any PE kits not in school for lessons.
