



Developing life skills, championing character

The SkillForce Prince's Award, supported by our Royal Patron HRH The Duke of Cambridge KG KT, is unique. It is designed to help students develop teamwork, problem-solving and leadership skills as well as boost their confidence and help them communicate more effectively. The award is a great opportunity for pupils age 8 and up to enjoy and value learning whilst gaining skills for life.

Part of an innovative collection of character and resilience education programmes, this award focuses on encouraging positive traits such as confidence, resilience and self-esteem through exciting challenges and reflective learning.

The programme is taught by our 'heroes in schools' - instructors who often have an Armed Forces background and are inspirational role models to young people.

Participants gain nationally recognised awards in First Aid and Navigation as well as an official certificate of completion. The 12 or 18 week programme gives learners the time and space to explore their identity and capabilities and to connect with their goals and aspirations.





How does it work?

- The award is completed during term time over 12 or 18 weeks.
- Each SkillForce Prince's Award session is two hours long.
- The 18 week course is more flexible and schools can choose to add on extra modules for this option.
- Pupils complete a log book to record and reflect upon their achievement.
- Pupils are assessed on four of the eight core values:
 - *Confidence*
 - *Teamwork*
 - *Communication*
 - *Problem solving*
- Assessment is made up from pupil, teacher and instructor observations.
