## Lost Property.

From time to time children may lose or misplace an item of their uniform. Parents are reminded that all uniform, coats/jackets <u>must</u> be clearly marked with your child's name. It is extremely difficult for lost property to be returned to its rightful owner if there is no name inside. If your child accidentally brings another child's clothing home with them can we ask that this be returned to school as soon as possible. Thank you.

## Uniform/School Shoes.

I have noticed recently that some children are coming into school wearing their yellow PE shirts. Can in remind parents that the yellow polo shirts should be worn for PE only. Children are expected to wear either a white polo shirt or white cotton shirt as part of their school uniform. I have also noticed a growing number of children wearing trainers in school. These should be worn for PE only. Appropriate black/brown school shoes should be worn in line with our school policy.

**Drinking Water Bottles.** Your child should have their drinking water bottle in school each day. Drinking water throughout the day has been shown to improve concentration.

The third instalment for your child's stay at Hawkhirst in September is due to be paid by 25th May, thank you to those parents who have sent this payment into school.

### <u>Hair Style's.</u>

Please can you ensure that your child has their hair cut in accordance with our school policy, if your child has long hair please make sure it is tied up before school.
